

JAANANKALLIO: Blackadder Wall

A 10 meter high wall 50 metres left of Sile Stone. Follow a path from the left edge of the crag past a short wall until the rock face can be seen rising above a small pile of blocks and short bushes (it has an obvious dead tree on top). The wall is best approached from its left edge. The climbing is on very high quality, featured rock. Although steep the abundance of features means that the climbing is rarely hard. Lord Flashheart and Baldrick are great beginners lines or warm up routes for those aspiring to climb on the main wall.

The wall is named Blackadder after an especially black Adder was sighted nearby.

1. **Captain Rum, 5a, ***: The technical, slabby arete (*Jody Wren, 09/08*).
- 2a. **Wee Jock Poo-Pong McPlop, 6a, ***: Tackles the triangular hole (*Jody Wren, 09/08*).
- 2b. **Project**: Right from the triangular hole.
3. **Blackadder, 6b+, ****: Fingery climbing up the middle of the wall (*Simon Bell, 09/08*).
- 4a. **Lord Flashheart, 5b, ****: Steep but juggy climbing left of the crack (*Jody Wren, 09/08*).
- 4b. **Baron Manfred von. Richthofen, 5b**: Project start closer to the crack.
5. **Baldrick, 4+, ***: Interesting and well protected crack climbing (*Toby Archer, 09/08*).
